SECOND GRADE NEWS

The 1st marking period was very busy for students in 2nd grade. We got organized for small group work in both reading and math. We became familiar with the routines of a 2nd grade classroom and we got used to the workload for each day. Now we are on a roll and ready to take our learning forward by leaps and bounds.

Students have already completed an assignment titled “All About Me”, designed and created a community map, and conducted a few experiments about plants. Students have chosen animals for their research project and started to learn how to use the internet to find information about these animals.

In Social Studies, we are learning the difference between rural, urban and suburban areas. In Science, we are looking at how plants and animals live together and are part of a Food Web. In Math, students are learning about place value and numbers unto 100. In *Foundations*, we are learning about vowel teams and glued sounds. In writing, students are focused on creating good sentences that can answer the questions who, what, when, where, why and how. Lastly, in reading, students are working to improve reading & comprehension. There is a lot of work done and lots more to do!
